I Hope to see many of you at the reunion dinner on April 2nd.

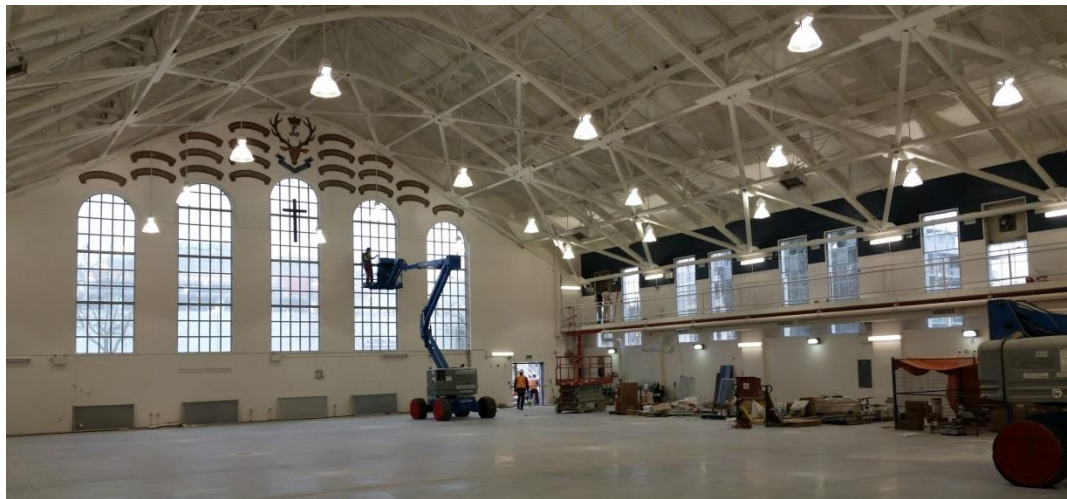

The trip to Vimy Ridge for the 100th anniversary of the battle still has open positions. Currently there are 39 people signed up to go. The trip will cost approximately \$4500.00 including airfare, accommodations, and tours of the battle fields that have been custom designed for the Seaforths. For those of you who have already made the initial deposit, the next installment is \$675.00 and is due by the end of March. For those wishing to secure a position the current amount needed is \$975.00.

Seaforth Hockey Team

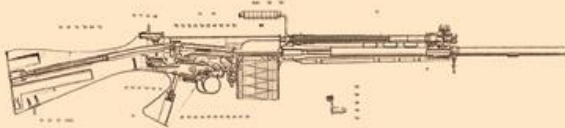
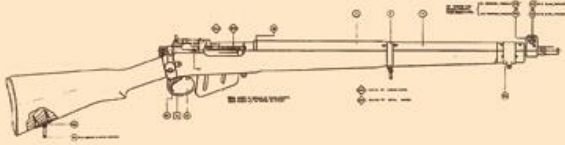
